

# **Flow to Apply & Fees**

Visit http://admission.hust.edu.cn, register online, upload all the documents required and submit the application.

Pay 100 USD as application fee.

Wait for the confirmation of admission from the system.

Wait for Admission Notice and JW202 Form (this form is only for students who study for more than 6 months at HUST)

Apply for X1/X2 Visa with your *Admission Notice* and other documents required in the Chinese Embassy in your country.

(X1 Visa: learn more than 6 months; X2 Visa: learn less than 6 months).

Get prepared and come to HUST during the registration period.

# **Chinese Summer Program (CSP)**

Chinese Summer Program (CSP) aims to introduce and display Chinese culture and China's general condition to students through lectures, seminars and activities in a period of 2-6 weeks. Since 2010, we have collaborated with universities from other countries like France, the UK, America, Australia, New Zealand and Mongolia. There have been more than 1000 international students who have joined CSP so far and 8 parts are covered as below:

### Chinese language learning

Main Courses: Chinese listening, speaking, reading guided by well-selected textbooks.

#### Lectures on Chinese culture

Popular topics like Chinese characters, Chinese festivals, Chinese art will be introduced in an interesting way.

#### Chinese talent show

Things to learn: Making Chinese dumplings, paper cutting and Chinese knots; Practicing calligraphy; Appreciating Guzheng (traditional Chinese zither) and Taiji performance.

#### Entertainments and sports activities

For program participants and Chinese students: 1) Party; 2) Football competition.

#### Sightseeing in Wuhan

Famous scenic spots in Wuhan: 1) Yellow Crane Tower and Hubuxiang Lane; 2) Yangtze River, East Lake, Hankou Beach and Jianghanlu Pedestrian Street; 3) Guiyuan Temple; 4) Hubei Provincial Museum; 5) Hubei Museum of Art; 6) HUST Science Park; 7) Wuhan National Opto Lab and so on.

### Sightseeing outside Wuhan

Mt. Wudang and Three Gorges Dam are recommended (optional/fee exclusive in the tuition).

# 3+3 Program

3+3 Program consists of 3-month Chinese learning and 3-month internship in Chinese companies mainly in HUST Science Park. Founded in 2000, it's a high-tech center for 55 enterprises covering various fields like IT, photoelectron, numerical control and electrical category, cast finance, business incubation, cultural publishing, creative design and architectural design etc.

3+3 Program has run for 6 years and is in good collaboration with international partners like Rheinisch-Westfaelische Technische Hochschule Aachen(Germany); University of Birmingham(UK) and Institut Supérieurd' Electronique de Paris(France).

#### 3+3 Program includes:

Language learning: 20 hours / week

Main courses like Elementary Comprehensive Chinese, Chinese Reading, Chinese Listening, Chinese Speaking, Business Chinese and China Panorama are offered.

Internship: 8 hours / day

Students will be divided into different groups according to their interest and be allocated to the respective enterprises to finish certain assignments.

#### Cultural activities and sightseeing

Learn Kongfu / Chinese calligraphy / paper cutting; Visiting Wuhan scenic spots and enterprises. Oping Ceremony and Closing Ceremony

Certificate of Completion / Certificate of Internship will be granted in the closing ceremony.

#### Notes for CSP and 3+3 Program:

- 1) Adaptation could be made based on personal needs.
- 2) No special request on Chinese language proficiency is needed for the applicants.
